- What do they need to know?
- What do they already know?

Think in terms of:

- 1. Role
- 2. Workflow
- 3. Data Comfort & Skills
- 4. Business & Data Expertise

	Questions	Implication
Role	What decisions do they make? What questions do they need answered?	Structure the information to make it super easy to answer high priority questions.
Work flow	In what context will they be reviewing the dashboard? What information are they using on a daily basis? How much time do they have to review the numbers?	The form and information display needs to fit into an existing work flow. For example, an on-the-road sales person may need information delivered to her BlackBerry, not designed for an online wide-screen monitor.
Data comfort and skills	How sophisticated are they with using data? Are they proficient in Excel? Do they enjoy digging into the numbers?	The dashboard's level of detail and analytical capabilities should match the audiences' comfort zone.
Business and data expertise	How familiar are they with the key performance metrics? Do they understand where the data comes from? Are they familiar with internal company or industry terminology?	This determines the need for embedded explanations and use of natural language.
