The following codes are valid citizenship status/visa codes for the Corporate Student System. In order to properly categorize students in cases where the specific residence or visa status code is unknown, use OT for international visa holders whose specific visa type is unknown and report blank/missing for domestic non-visa holders whose status is unknown. Students with missing codes are treated by the system as domestic.
