Re: Changes to Input Specifications for CSS Financial Support Files

Dear Colleagues:

Beginning with the January 2025 financial aid submission, UCOP is requesting the addition of two new fields in the demographic portion of the CSS Financial Support input (academic and summer) files. Under new Federal guidelines, the Maximum Pell Indicator (R350) and the Minimum Pell Indicator (R360) identify alternative criteria to determine a student's eligibility for the Pell Grant. The University requires these additional Pell flags to determine student financial need more accurately for the purposes of informing Undergraduate Student Aid Program (USAP) funding allocations to campuses under the Education Financing Model (EFM).
