Re: Changes to Input Specifications for CSS Financial Support Files

Dear Colleagues:

Beginning with the October 2023 financial support submission, UCOP is requesting two new fields in the CSS Financial Support input files and clarifying the definition of an existing field.

The Legal Name-Student (G010) in the demographic portion of the CSS Financial Support file clarifies and replaces the former Name-Student and will now be limited to the applicant's legal name per the UC Presidential Policy on Lived Name.

The Lived Name - Student (R350) is a new field in the demographic portion of the CSS Financial Support file required to support the UC Presidential Policy on Lived Name. This should reflect the preferred or lived name of a student if different from the legal name. This may be blank if the lived and legal name are the same.

The CCOA Entity Code (S120) is a new field in the award portion of the CSS Financial Support file required to support the migration to the new Common Chart of Accounts financial coding system. Entity code is a fundamental part of the key to distinguish fund and account source under the new Common Chart of Accounts. This field must be provided when campus is converted to the new financial system, else a value of spaces must be supplied.

The New CCOA Account ID (S130) is a new field in the award portion of the CSS Financial Support file required to support the migration to the new Common Chart of Accounts financial coding system. This is the account ID that is used by the new chart of accounts and is at level E. This field must be provided when campus has converted to the new financial system, else a value of spaces must be supplied.

The New CCOA Fund ID (S140) is a new field in the award portion of the CSS Financial Support file required to support the migration to the new Common Chart of Accounts financial coding system. This is the fund ID that is used by the new chart of accounts and is at level D. This field must be provided when campus has converted to the new financial system, else a value of spaces must be supplied.

When a campus has converted to the new financial system, Entity Code (S120), New CCOA Account ID (S130), and New CCOA Fund ID (S140) will need to have valid values from the new financial system. Existing old CCOA fields -, Account Number(S010), Fund Number(S020) and Subaccount Number (S030) will eventually be discontinued when all campuses are converted over and will all have a value of spaces.
