

## Guidelines for Determining Flow Through Codes

The campus Contract and Grant Office (or the Development Office in the case of gifts) is responsible for providing the Accounting Office with sufficient information to assign a code value.

### APPLICABLE FUND GROUPS

Flow Through Code is required for funds in the fund groups listed below, if such funds were established for the purpose of a gift, contract, grant, or other agreement, and if said funds are associated with expenditure accounts.

Current Funds: Private Gifts, Grants & Contracts	408100	Unrestricted Gifts

Note: By policy, any funds in the federal groups (100200, 100210, 406210, 406230, 406310, 406340) should be funded entirely by federal funds. Any campus not adhering to this policy will have to identify the appropriate fund numbers and assign a value of '2' or '6' to them. Campuses are not required to assign codes to federal funds, with this exception.

### GIFTS TO THE UNIVERSITY

As of fiscal year 1999-2000, Flow Through Code is required for Gifts. See Appendix C: Fund Attribute Edits for the appropriate values.
